

SBCC WOMEN'S LACROSSE CLUB CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I

The name of this club will be Santa Barbara City College Women's Lacrosse Club.

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

The purpose of this club is to improve lacrosse skills throughout the community of women at SBCC. It will also serve as a competitive sport to play against other club women's lacrosse teams.

ARTICLE III

(Authority)

The club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IV

(Membership)

Membership is open to all students at SBCC who are interested and eligible to play women's lacrosse.

ARTICLE V

(Meetings)

Meetings will be held periodically throughout the year to discuss certain topics involving the team. The meetings will be advised by the advisor of the club. These meetings will also meet to practice skills.

ARTICLE VI

(Officers)

Two Club Presidents - Preside over all meetings, organize and call meetings, coordinate lacrosse games and communicate with other school's women's lacrosse teams in our division. Display as orderly role models to the members of the club.

Secretary - Record duration of meetings (table at least five hours per semester). Responsible for reaching out to members. Handles club funds.

Director of Student/Faculty Outreach - Keeps contact with organization members and ensures the student body is aware of events. Keep in contact with faculty and staff of Santa Barbara City College.

ARTICLE VII

(Elections)

Officers are expected to serve the entirety of the school year as well as have a new election each year including the positions mentioned previously. If an officer must abandon their position, a special election will be held.

ARTICLE VIII

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 90% of the club officers or 75% of club members.
